Stud Member Benefits

Full Stud Members of the Australian Galloway Association are entitled to receive the following benefits:

1. Advertise cattle for sale or semen for sale on the AGA Web Site free of charge.
2. Include link to own website on AGA Website free of charge.
3. Advertise cattle for sale in the Classifieds of the AGA Galloway News at a nominal fee.
4. Advertise your stud in the Galloway Annual at Members' rates.
5. Receive via email, all enquiries received by the AGA Office, on a regular basis.
6. Receive assistance with promotional material/banners for use at Field Days/Shows/etc.
7. Receive assistance with site fees at Field Days.
8. Have access to the AGA Executive Officer who deals solely with matters relating to Galloways, Belted Galloways and Miniature Galloways.
9. Cattle are registered in a secure Herd Book with ABRI which is available online.
10. Vote at all General Meetings of the Association.
11. Receive the Galloway Annual and quarterly Newsletters.

The Association

The Australian Galloway Association is the premier body for registering Galloway cattle in Australia. With around 200 members, stud, commercial and junior, it offers secure herdbook registrations for Galloways, Belted Galloways and miniature Galloways.

The herdbook registrations are carried out by ABRI, the Agricultural Business Research Institute located at the University of New England, Armidale; the leading herd book registration institution in Australia and respected worldwide for providing software services to agricultural industries. The Association's herdbook is online and available for public viewing, allowing interested breeders the ability to easily research bloodlines.
